A Message From the School Nurse:

Dear Parents/Guardians of our 2024-2025 Students,

If your student will need to keep medications at school this year, it is **MANDATORY** that you and a physician fill out and sign one of the forms attached below. Students are absolutely **not allowed** to carry any form of pills, eye drops, nasal sprays, etc. at school, even if they are Over-the-Counter. These all need to be kept in the nurse's office with the signed Medication Order form.

The only medications that students are allowed to carry are inhalers and epi pens, but those must be signed off on by their doctor in the appropriate section on the Medication at School Form (Form A if allergy related).

Medication at School Forms

Life-Threatening Allergies - Medication at School Form (FORM A: Allergies)

Use this form for mild to severe food allergies or other allergies, such as bee stings or other environmental allergens. A new form is required yearly or whenever there is a change in the information provided. You do not also need to submit the generic *Medication at School* form.

Medication at School Form (FORM B: General Form)

Use this form for all medication at school, including prescription and over-the-counter (OTC) medications. A new form is required each school year or whenever there is a change in the information provided.
