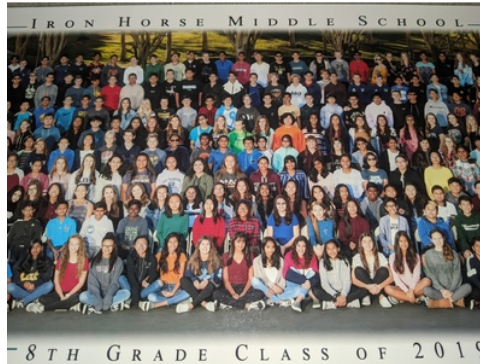

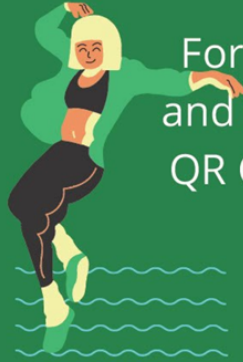

All incoming freshmen interested in the Performing Dance Program at SRVHS should participate in the upcoming auditions.

SINCE SCHOOL REGISTRATION IS BEFORE THE COMPLETION OF AUDITIONS, WHEN YOU REGISTER YOU SHOULD SIGN UP FOR *INTRODUCTION TO DANCE*; YOU WILL BE PLACED IN THE APPROPRIATE CLASS AFTER AUDITIONS.

You have the following options:

1. You may sign up for Introduction to Dance as a Fine Arts elective course. This class is taken in addition to Frosh PE. This course fulfills the Fine Arts elective requirement for all college admissions. There is NO audition necessary for Introduction to Dance.
2. You may audition for Dance Performance A/B, Dance Composition A/B and Dance Production A/B. If you qualify you will receive Fine Arts elective credit which would also count towards the university elective requirement for college entry. You will be placed according to your audition results. If you do not make it into these levels you may take Introduction to Dance.

CLINICS/AUDITIONS: You must attend. Closed to family and friends – dancers only.

Place: Auxiliary Gym at SRVHS. All classes are open to males and females. You must complete the entire process to be considered for placement.

Monday, March 27—from 4:00 to 5:30pm.—Learn dance routine.

Tuesday, March 28—4:00-5:30pm. -Review the routine and review across the floor skills.

Wednesday, March 29—4:00 to 7:00pm. Across The Floor AUDITIONS. You must stay until you finish showing all skills.

Thursday, March 30—4:00 to 7:00pm. Dance Routine AUDITIONS; you may leave when you are done.

- If you have a conflict, please contact me in advance to see if we can make special arrangements as all auditions must be completed by the evening of Thursday, March 31.
- The class lists will be emailed to all participating dancers by Monday, April 10th. Included in the email will be a Google Form requesting your commitment to the class.

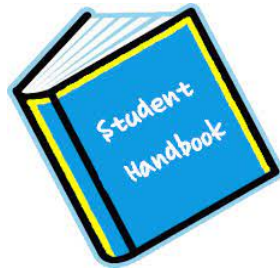
